## **Organiser's Advice**

The participants should arrange for their arrival in Bonn on Saturdays by 14:00 hrs. The seminar ends in Berlin on Sunday of the following week no later than 12:00 hrs.

Participants should make their own travel arrangements to and from the seminar venue.

They will be accommodated in single en-suite rooms in foundations, hotels or barracks of the Bundeswehr.

The seminar fee for each participant is Euro 300; it includes all accommodation and transport services (starting from Bonn to Berlin) as well as meals (half-board at the minimum).

Upon request a contribution to the travel costs for the journey to Bonn and from Berlin can be paid by the Bundeswehr Academy for Information and Communication.

The EUROPEAN Seminar is a public information event on security policy issues staged by the Federal Ministry of Defense. It brings together budding young German and European executives from the science community, the business sector and politics in order to give them a better understanding of the objectives of the security policy pursued by the Federal Republic of Germany and Europe as well as of the modern Bundeswehr.
